1. WHAT IS A URINARY TRACT INFECTION?	An infection of the bladder or kidneys	Kidney Ureters Bladder Vagina
2. WHAT ARE THE CAUSES OF A URINARY TRACT INFECTION?	Not washing your vagina inside and outside every day Wiping from back to front (getting stool in the vagina) Urine that stays in your bladder after you urinate Sick kidneys Wearing tight clothing Bacteria from having sex Violent sex	No!
3. SIGNS OF A URINARY TRACT INFECTION	Burning or pain when passing urine Passing urine frequently or suddenly Bloody urine Cloudy urine Urine that smells bad Lower back pain Feeling tired or sick Becoming suddenly confused	urine smells bad



## PREVENTING URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS

#### 5. PREVENTION

- Always wipe from front to back
- Don't wait to urinate. Go to the bathroom frequently
- Go to the bathroom before and after sex
- Wear loose-fitting and cotton clothes Tight fitting clothes don't let air circulate.
- Drink as much clean water as you can






## TREATMENT OF URINARY TRACT INFECTIONS

- Take any medication that is prescribed until it is gone
- It is important to keep any medicine away from your children
- Drink a lot of clean water with your medicine
- Stop having sex until you feel better and your medicine is finished


9. HOW TO STAY HEALTHY	Drink as much clean water as you can.     Mix in a little baking soda if you can.     Drink cranberry juice every day     Wash your vagina every day	
10. CLEAN CATCH URINE SAMPLE	Wash your hands     Use a wet paper towel or alcohol wipe     Wipe from front to back     Throw out the towel     Hold your vagina open     Urinate a little into the toilet or on the ground     Urinate into the cup     Finishing urinating into the toilet or on the ground     Give the cup to the doctor or nurse	




